I don't know about you, but I very much enjoy cooking. Sadly, time to enjoy my hobby seems to be rather limited. One of the joys of food is its seasonal variation. The gardeners among you will be sowing seeds and looking forward to the growth of vegetables and fruit in due course. Seasonal and fresh fruit and vegetables have a superior taste to that grown out of season or foods which are air freighted in from other parts of the world.

In this season of Lent and as we approach Easter, special foods are starting to appear in the shops. Distinctive hot cross buns, full of flavoursome spices and marked with the symbol of Jesus' crucifixion. Simnel cakes are another Easter delicacy, decorated with balls of marzipan to represent Jesus' disciples. Easter displays are appearing in shop windows. When I was recently in York, a famous bakers' shop had a window display full of hot cross buns, simnel cakes and chocolate Easter eggs. The window was further decorated with spring flowers, fluffy toy chicks and rabbits. Lambs are appearing in fields and soon shops will be advertising lamb for the Easter feast.

These special foods act as signposts pointing to deeper truths in the Christian faith. Simnel cake points to the role of Jesus' disciples in the Easter story, hot cross buns are symbolic of his death on the cross. Roast lamb is a reminder of Jesus, the lamb of God who sacrificed himself on the cross. Finally, chocolate Easter eggs point to new life, Jesus being resurrected after his death.



As well as enjoying the culinary delights of Easter, all are welcome to participate in the worship being held in our churches throughout Holy Week and Easter. We are holding a range of worship around the benefice so that all who wish can join in the journey towards the cross and celebrate Jesus' resurrection, his coming back to life on Easter Day. You are very welcome to just turn up to any service in any village. Feel free to have a chat with me if you have any questions.

Sunday 29th March -Palm Sunday- 10.30am Hickling- We celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. There will be an opportunity to take part in a short Palm Sunday procession. Rev Lucy Dallas, Diocesan Director of Ordinands will be our visiting preacher at this service.

Monday 30th March- 6.30pm Stations of the Cross- Ridlington- A service of readings and prayers telling the story of the last days of Jesus' life.

Tuesday 31st March- 6.30pm Compline- Walcott- A quiet and reflective end to the day by candlelight.

Wednesday 1st April- 8.15pm Tenebrae- Hickling- A retelling of the Passion Story and extinguishing of candles. The service begins in light and ends in darkness. Bring a torch.

Maundy Thursday 2nd April- 6.30pm Maundy Thursday Communion with stripping of the altar- Sea Palling- A special service focussing on Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples.

Good Friday 3rd April- On Good Friday we remember Jesus' death on the cross. There are services in Lessingham, Sea Palling and Bacton and at 2pm in Hickling a Walk of Witness from Hickling Methodist Church to St Mary's.

Easter Day 5th April- We celebrate Jesus' resurrection, his coming back to life. If you are an early riser, you could dress warmly and come to Sea Palling beach at 6am for an informal sunrise service. This will be followed by bacon rolls or alternatives and warm drinks. There will be more traditional Easter services at Hickling, Bacton, Happisburgh, Walcott and Witton. See times in the list of services. Come to Ridlington at 3pm to sing well known Easter hymns followed by tea and cake.
