

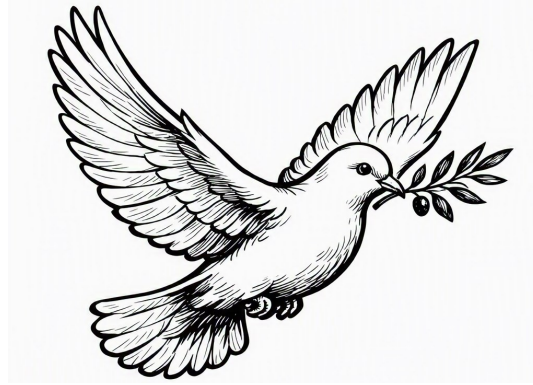

Unfortunately, by no fault of their own, Bacton Bingo are unable to continue raising essential funds for this Walcott-On-Sea collection point. We sincerely thank Gill Hawkes, Suzanne Petrou and Kathy Hilton from Bacton for all their hard work and dedication over the past two years: Enabling us to save 84 wheelie bins full from ending up in landfill. We have lobbied for funding from NNDC & M.P.s, even having our request raised in parliament, but are sorry to say that we have been unsuccessful in gaining support.

Everyone involved in this effort feels very disappointed that this ecological service will now have to be withdrawn. We are, however, making enquiries for an alternative local village collection point to be initialised. So 'watch this space' for future information.

**What to do if you find a Baby Birdie** - if a bird is out of its nest, providing a cat hasn't had any interaction, and also appears undamaged, just pick it up and pop it back in! In any other situation, contain it, keep it warm but NOT on a hot water bottle as it will overheat (if they are gasping they are NOT thirsty just too hot). Keep it safe and telephone for advice. Most importantly, please DO NOT give baby birds any food (unless otherwise told to by rescue centre) and ESPECIALLY NO WATER. Ring for rescue advice ASAP.

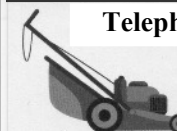
