In a recent conversation with one of our local headteachers, our discussion turned to the time of year. She commented how it would soon be dark by the end of the school day. The darkness at this time of year can be overwhelming and I know that some people find it very challenging to venture out after dark.

Darkness can be difficult but there can be real joy in seeing lights shining in the darkness. Two years ago, when I began my ministry in the Coastal Group, one particularly vivid memory is walking towards the church on a dark, frosty evening along a path lit by fairy lights, church bells ringing and light shining from the windows.

Jesus is sometimes described as the light of the world, overcoming the darkness and bringing hope in difficult and uncertain times. The theme of our Christmas services this year will be joy. At Christmas, Christians joyfully celebrate God coming to earth to live among us as a baby born by Mary. We will hear again the story of Jesus' birth in Bethlehem and his being visited by humble shepherds and magi from exotic parts with gifts for the new King.

The carol service in Hickling moves from darkness to light and includes choir items. We even hold informal carol services in The Hill House, Happisburgh and The Lifeboat, Sea Palling. For a family friendly Crib and Christingle service come to Happisburgh on Christmas Eve. Wild Touch (Mill Common Road, Ridlington)

Leaves provide shelter for insects and other invertebrates which are an important food source for birds and other wildlife. Collect them up and add them to your wild corner of the garden or compost heap or under hedges for the hedgehogs who will take them to their shelters for hibernation. Don't cut back all your perennial plants, their stems offer over wintering sites for insects and the seed heads provides food for birds.
